What data do we collect?

D3 Events collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number, date of birth, postal address, cookie information)

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide D3 Events with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register on line for an entry into Mud Runner Lite
- Contact us via our email or website contact page.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

How will we use your data?

D3 Events collects your data so that we can:

- Process your entry and manage your additional requests
- Identify you during the race in case of emergencies.
- Identify you in case of medical requirements
- Email you prior to the event with specific information about the event you have entered.
- Email you post event with closing details and a link for purchasing photos

D3 Events will not share your information with any third party organisation other than those connected to the above eg. Medical Team

How do we store your data?

D3 Events securely stores your data on our cloud based server.

D3 Events will keep your data for 3 years for insurance purposes. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data.

Marketing

D3 Events or any of our partners will not send you information about products and services

What are your data protection rights?

D3 Events would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access - You have the right to request D3 Events for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that D3 Events correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request D3 Events to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure - You have the right to request that D3 Events erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request that D3 Events restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to D3 Events' processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability - You have the right to request that D3 Events transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
